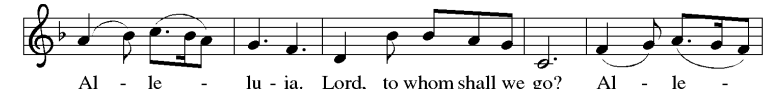
Prayer of the Day
